Entries and Events

This meet is open to Masters Swimming Queensland (MSQ) registered swimmers, and swimmers registered with other Masters Swimming Australia (MSA) affiliated clubs. International swimmers who meet the clearance criteria may also compete. No guest swimmers. For swimmers considering joining Masters Swimming, 6 month Masters memberships are available.

Entries are to be submitted via Entry Manager located on the Member Forum of the MSQ website. The closing date for individual entries is midnight on Friday 27 September 2019.

A swimmer may enter a maximum of five (5) competition events for \$25. Relay and exhibition entries are free.

All entries requested after closing may incur a late nomination fee of \$10.00 per event. Late entries are subject to lane availability in the event, and may result in swimmers being entered in the slowest heat.

Relay entries are to be submitted online also via Entry Manager using the Club Relay Teams link, and will remain open until Monday 30 September 2019.

New Club Captains, Interstate and international swimmers and teams are to contact the Meet Director for entry procedure information.

Heats will be swum from fastest to slowest. The fastest ranked heat will be heat 1 of each event.

Entry List, Timeline and Program

The entry list will be available on the event page of the MSQ website on Saturday 5 October 2019. All competitors must check their entries thoroughly and submit discrepancies to the Meet Director by midnight, Tuesday 8 October, 2019. The timeline for this meet will be published on the event page of the MSQ website on or before Thursday 10 October 2019. Programs are available for download online prior to and during the meet.

Relays

Only club relays are allowed - no composite teams. Relays shall consist of four swimmers each registered with the same club. No swimmer is allowed to represent more than one club.

All clubs captains must complete relay nominations and payments online. There is no limit on the number of teams a club may enter in any age group. All teams may score points.

Swimmers must enter at least one individual event to be eligible to swim in a relay team. A swimmer may only swim a particular relay event once. Relays are to be swum in the order swimmers are nominated in their entry. Mixed relays must consist of two (2) males and two (2) females. The order of swimmers by gender is optional in mixed relays.

If on the day of the event a nominated swimmer cannot swim a relay due to unforeseen circumstances such as illness, a club may, at the discretion of the Meet Director, in advance of the

event, substitute another swimmer from the same club. If in doubt, nominate a team and withdraw it on the day.

Exhibition – Event 8 – 50m Fin Freestyle

All registered swimmers are welcome to enter this exhibition, no points event. There is no additional cost and it is not included as one of your five event allowance. Prizes of \$50 will be awarded to each male and female swimming closest to their nominated time. This event will be an “in-water” start using any style of fins. Note the rules specified in the Meet Guide.

Results

Live results will be made available for this meet. The Meet Mobile application will be operating and can be downloaded to your chosen device(s). Results will be posted to the MSA Portal, and a PDF results file and statistics will be published on the MSQ website.

Meet awards

Awards will be presented at the conclusion of this meet at the UQ Aquatic Centre:

- Club with the highest aggregate points total.
- Club with the highest average point score – small.
- Club with the highest average point score – large.
- Individual points first, second, and third.
- Relay award – overall closest to nominated time.
- Exhibition Fin Freestyle - male and female.

Other Details

- Members from all clubs may be called on to assist with timekeeping throughout the meet.
- Food and drinks, including fresh coffee will be available for sale from the UQ Aquatic Centre canteen throughout the event.
- Free undercover event parking will be available adjacent to the UQ Aquatic Centre in Parking Station P10.
- If the meet is affected by storms, a mandatory safety suspension of events will be imposed. This may require a shortened event format which will be determined by the Meet Director and UQ Aquatic Centre staff. No refund of entry fees will occur under such circumstances.
