Meet Details

Entries

This meet is open to Masters registered swimmers only.

Entries are to be submitted via Quick Entry located on the MSQ website. Please note entries will open in February 2021.

The closing date for individual nominations is Sunday 14 March 2021.

Club Captains, interstate and international swimmers and teams are to contact the MSQ Director of Recording for entry procedure information.

Note: numbers are strictly limited to the first 200 paid entrants.

Events

Please note: Heats will be swum from fastest to slowest. The fastest seeded heat will be heat 1 of each event.

There are no relays at this meet.

All events will be conducted as timed finals.

Entry fees

All entrants must pay the nomination fee online as directed by Quick Entry. Swimmers may enter up to four (4) individual events for \$10.

Warm-up start time

Warm-up for this meet will commence in the 50m pool at 12:00PM with lanes 0 to 7 closing at 12:15PM. Lanes 8 and 9 of the 50m pool will remain open throughout the duration of the meet for warm-up and swim down. Competition will commence at 12:30PM.

Results

Live results will be made available for this meet via the Meet Mobile application downloaded to your chosen device. Results will be posted at the venue soon after the completion of each event. Final results will be updated to the MSA Portal, and a PDF results file will be published to the MSQ website.

Records

This pool has a certified survey of length. Results will appear on the National Results Portal. Queensland and Australian records may be set at this meet, and results are eligible for FINA World Top 10.

Meet awards

Medals and awards will not be presented at this meet.

Self Marshaling

All swimmers will be required to self-marshal. Swimmers and officials are to be physically distanced and minimise contact with surfaces. People who are not swimming or officiating should not be near the start end of the pool during the meet.

- Seating is no longer permitted in the marshaling area.
- No clothing or gear is to be taken to the blocks.
- Swimmers are responsible for knowing the event/heat/lane they are competing in, and for being aware of what event/heat is currently in the water. The Meet Announcer will be calling the heat number in the water after the start of every heat.
- An entrant who fails to report to the Marshaling area prior to their heat being called at the blocks will be deemed withdrawn.
- No more than four (4) heats of swimmers are permitted in the marshaling area including behind the blocks.
- The Self Marshaling Entry List and the Meet Program will be posted at the venue.

Other information

- MSQ will continually reassess meet details due to the evolving COVID-19 situation to ensure that swimmers' well-being is the highest priority.
- Members from all clubs will be called on to assist with timekeeping throughout the meet.
- Clubs are encouraged to bring their own tents and will be assigned a location once final numbers are known. Tents must be pegged or weighted.
- Free event parking will be available adjacent to the Aquatic Centre.
- If the meet is affected by storms, a mandatory safety suspension of events will be imposed. This may require a shortened event format. No refund of entry fees will occur under such circumstances.
