Eligibility

This swim meet is open to all registered Masters Swimming Australia (MSA) members, non-member/guest swimmers and junior swimmers from 14 years of age. Minimum age is 14 years at day of competition. No late entries will be accepted and no entries on the day. Age as at 31 December 2022.

Entries

All entrants must register an account and submit entries in [Swim Central](#). Entries will open in October 2022 and close on 18 November 2022. Please contact the [Director of Recording](#) for any issues

Please note, if you are registering an account for your child who is under 18, you must first register yourself and then create a family group. See [Swim Central Support](#).

Non-members/guests

Non-member/guests will need to:

1. Register a Swim Central account (if you do not have one already) and log in with your email address
2. Purchase an event membership of \$5 (plus fees)
 - a. Click on Store in left menu
 - b. Click Memberships link
 - c. Search for "Masters Swimming Queensland" in Find a Club
 - d. Add "Big Barrine Bash OWS Non-Member 2022" membership to your Cart and purchase
 - e. Once purchased, you will be able to enter the OWS meet via your home page or the Events link
3. Enter the meet paying the applicable entry fee

Relay entries – please read carefully

Relay swimmers will need to log in to Swim Central and enter this meet selecting, and paying for their relay leg via **Event 5**. Event 5 is not a contestable event and exists only to allow entrants to enter the relay event. Each relay team member will be required to pay their \$20 portion of the \$80 relay fee (plus fees).

Masters club members

- Club Race Secretaries will create relay teams from registered relay entrants in Swim Central

Non-masters entrants

- Non-member relay Team Leaders must email team member names and swim order to the [Director of Recording](#) who will create the team in Swim Central.

Entry fees - excluding GST and administration fees

Swimmers may enter only one event. All entrants must pay the nomination fee for individual events online as directed by Swim Central. Fee includes a swim cap, insurance and fruit.

Non-Masters entrants will purchase an additional \$5 meet membership prior to entering the meet.

Swimwear

No wetsuits, no zips in swimwear and no flotation devices as per the Masters Swimming Swimwear and Open Water Swimming rules. Please refer to [MSA Swimwear Rules](#).

Watches/Timing Devices

No watches, timing or pacing devices of any description are permitted as per the MSA OWS rules.

Rules

All Masters Swimming Australia, FINA Swimming, and Rottneest Channel Swimming rules apply. By nominating to participate in this swim meet, all swimmers thereby authorise the Meet Director/MSQ Officials to take whatever action is deemed necessary in the event of an emergency, and persons involved accept responsibility for any and all costs arising from such action.

Masters Swimming Australia and Rottneest Channel Swim Association rules and regulations will be strictly adhered to.

Registration / Briefing / Start times

All swimmers must attend the briefing. No briefing, no swim.

Timeline

The 10km swim must be completed within 4 ¼ hours as per the 2023 Rottnest Channel Swim Association rules.

All swimmers are to have completed their swim and exited the water by 12:15pm.

Entry List

The entry list will be available on the event page of the MSQ website on Sunday 21 November 2022. All competitors must check their entries thoroughly and submit discrepancies to the Director of Recording by 23 November 2022.

Swim Waiver

Each swimmer must sign a 'swim waiver' on the day. Junior swimmers require a parent or guardian signature also.

Medical Certificates/Medication

Medical certificates and/or medication lists must be emailed to [Cheryl Brodribb](#).

Late entries

No late entries will be accepted. No entries on the day.

Marshaling

All swimmers will be required to meet at the water entry point for their allocated distance five minutes prior to their start time. Swimmers are not to enter the water until advised by the MSQ Technical Director and Chief Official. Swimmers and Officials are to be physically distanced. People who are not swimming or officiating should not be near the starting/finishing area. Events to be marshaled will be announced.

Feeders

Only the 10km and 5km swimmers may have 'feeders'. You may have your own 'feeder person' or we will provide a 'feeder person' for you. Please advise [Cheryl Brodribb](#) if you require a 'feeder person' or who your 'feeder person' will be. Each 'feeder person' may look after more than one swimmer. Swimmers, please name your esky and number your food.

Results

Results will be posted on the MSQ website within 3-4 days, in addition to the MSQ and mastersswimmingnq Facebook and Instagram pages.

Awards

- First, second and third in each open swim distance, for male and female.
- Junior swimmers overall first, second and third in each swim distance 14-18 years.

First Aid/Safety

A medic and lifeguards will be on duty, with an IRB equipped with a Jason's Cradle.

COVID-Safe Meet Information

To help reduce the spread of COVID-19 please:

- Do not attend if you are COVID-19 positive or have COVID-19 symptoms
- Maintain physical distancing to the extent possible outside of the pool
- Practice good hand hygiene, washing/sanitising hands often

Emergency Evacuation

In case of an emergency, swimmers, officials and safety personal will be directed to exit the water and go to the appropriate assembly point and await instructions. If asked to evacuate, please do so immediately.
