The journey ends with tastings of the products that they produce which highlight the many delicious uses of sugar, including rum, rum liqueurs and fruit liqueurs made onsite in the boutique distillery, plus their range of Chefs' Gusto chutneys, relishes and sauces, and non-alcoholic ginger beer.

Come and have a drink or a chat in the afternoon/evenings, if weather permits and no fire bans or risk of fire in the cane, we also light the fire pot. With tours available at certain times for people to learn more about Sugar cane. Sugar Cane Tour shows from planting to harvesting, how it gets to the mills here in the Mackay Region, some juicing, morning tea and much more! It even includes a tour of our John Deere replica museum. You won't be disappointed!
